- 1. THE BALL IS FOR 7TH & 8TH GRADERS ONLY!**
- 2. THIS BALL IS A LOCK-IN DANCE** - Once you're in, you're in. If you leave, you cannot re-enter for any reason.
- 3. THERE IS A DRESS CODE** - This is a formal affair. Jeans, khakis, be-dazzled tennis shoes, tennis shoes, walking canes, hats will NOT be allowed. In order to BEST represent themselves, students MUST conduct and present themselves as ladies and gentlemen. Dresses MUST be no more than 2 inches above the knee.
